# World Pro-Am DanceSport Series (DSS) Competitions

There are three age groups: Y (12 - 16) A (16 - 35), B (36 - 50), C (51 - over) & S1 (61 +) in each of the four styles. All divisions are unisex and levels are closed Bronze & Silver and Open Gold. The student can only represent one age and one style in November 2023. The teacher can be represented more than once. Points will be based on accumulation of callbacks and placements earned throughout the 2025 series events starting with the 2024 Ohio Star Ball.

## **Solo Routines**

No Solo Routine is to exceed three minutes. <u>Music will be faded out after 3 minutes</u>. All solo routine music must be on Memo Stick. Please make recordings carefully and use the best available equipment.

## **Competition Dress Codes for all Pro-Am events**

- Newcomer: Evening wear is suggested (Cocktail dresses for the ladies and jackets or vests for the Gentleman) For Solo Routines, costumes are acceptable.
